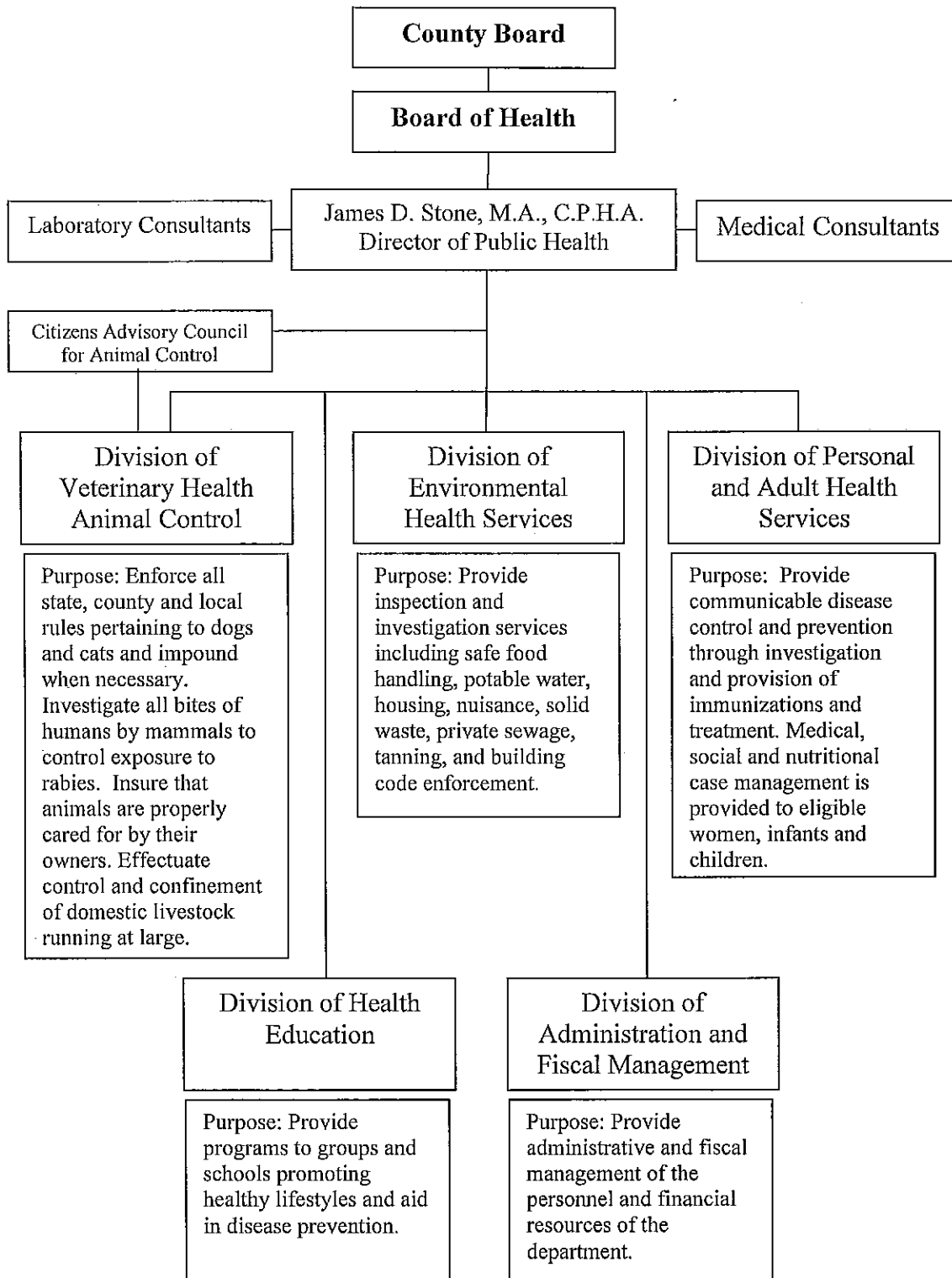
BUDGET: The SCDPH budget for Fiscal Year 2010 is \$8,821,864.

SCDPH OVERSIGHT: The health department is governed by a 10 member Board of Health appointed by the Sangamon County Board. The Board of Health is comprised of two physicians, one dentist, one registered nurse, one County Board member and five members at large.
